Deputy William "Bill" Lyles began his career with the Alameda County Sheriff's Office on January 1, 1960, and retired on March 26, 1989. During his 29-year career, Bill was assigned to Santa Rita Jail, Central Identification Bureau, Regional Training Center, Range Master and Work Furlough. He also worked many volunteer assignments as well as being a constant presence at the Alameda County Fair.
